Question 1: Jazmyn, I recently read a great book "Confidence Code" and there were so many high-ranking women that have low confidence, do you see that trait among your peers or others?

Response: With a resounding "Yes", Jazmyn believes that society plays a huge role because girls are graded by a different set of standards. Girls are judged by their external appearance, while boys, regardless of appearance, are accepted period. Plus, it's acceptable for young men to "have multiple girl friends, but young ladies are criticized. **Read John 4: 1-25** (the Women at the Well!)

Question 2: How can we change the trajectory of these negative images of young women?

Response: Mothers must speak and affirm their young daughters at an early age. Encourage them to speak up and express themselves respectfully. Mothers should be conscious of the things they say to their daughters so as not to undermine them in any way. Most importantly, mothers must find more constructive ways of communicating to their daughters. These and other things can stop the generational curse.

Question 3: Give me an example of how parents can eradicate those images?

Response: It is important that parents be more forthright and honest in sharing their youthful experiences. Jazmyn believes that would bridge the gap between mother and daughter and bring them closer. She believes it will also take the pressure off the parents to show an unreal image and reduce the "negative talk".

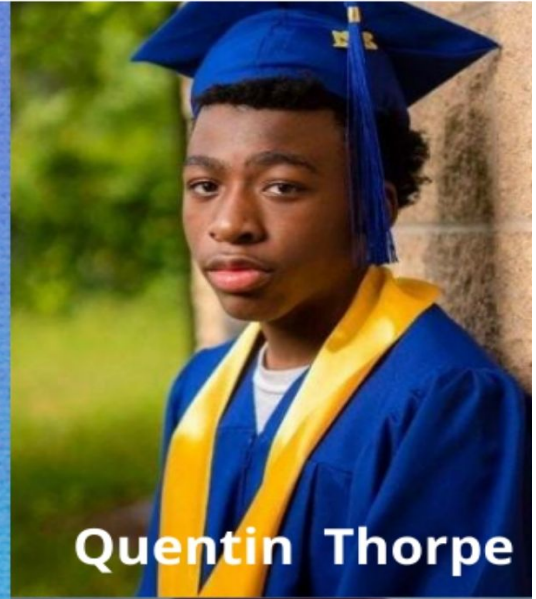

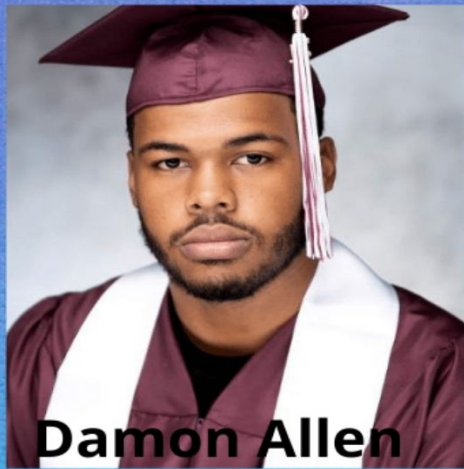

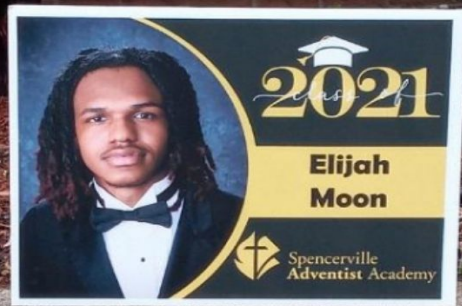
